

**The Law Amending the Law for Protection of Personal Privacy and Personal Security of
Citizens**

(The Pyidaungsu Hluttaw Law No. 16, 2020)

The 10th Waxing Day of Wagaung, 1382 M.E.

(28 August 2020)

The Pyidaungsu Hluttaw hereby enacts this Law.

1. This Law shall be called **the Law Amending the Law for Protection of Personal Privacy and Personal Security of Citizens.**
2. The introduction of Section 8 of the Law for Protection of Personal Privacy and Personal Security of Citizens shall be substituted as follows:
“8. No person who has duty and authority, without any permit, permission or warrant in accordance with existing laws or without the permission of the President or the Union Government, shall:”
3. Section 10 of the Law for Protection of Personal Privacy and Personal Security of Citizens shall be substituted as follows:
“10. If any person who has duty and authority violates any prohibition in section 7 or section 8, he or she shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend from a minimum of six months to a maximum of three years and also be liable to a fine from a minimum of three hundred thousand kyats to a maximum of one million and five hundred thousand kyats.”
4. After section 13 of the Law for Protection of Personal Privacy and Personal Security of Citizens, section 14 shall be inserted as follows:
“14. The relevant Ministry may issue notifications, orders, directives and procedures in implementing the provisions of this Law.”
